## FRINGE 'SUPERHERO'

### ALL SET TO CAMP IT UP AND SAVE THE DAY

**“Y**ou may have heard but the world is in disarray at the moment. “Who better to save the day than a hot pant-wearing, accordion-wielding, tap-dancing, part-time hand model, glamorous German?”

These are the words of the performer known as Hans, who is on a mission to pull Perth punters out of their stupor and make them fall in love with life again.

An international favourite, the star has duetted with Fergie and sung for Julia Gillard and Princess Mary, plus he holds the world record for continuous accordion playing (29.5 hours and exclusively Madonna songs).

He won the best cabaret gong at last year's Edinburgh and Adelaide fringe festivals but his appearance at WA's Fringe World with the show Mein Camp will be his first.

“The title says it all,” Hans, real name Matt Gilbertson, told AAA.

“There is certainly a lot of disco and a lot of camp classics. Let's just say there are a lot of things you may have heard at a community establishment known as Connections nightclub.”

“I also do a version of the song My Favourite Things from The Sound of Music

and that's quite popular.”

There's plenty of razzle-dazzle from his costumes, too.

“Just like Beyonce, my costumes have been hand-crafted by my own mother,” Hans laughed.

“I think you can agree, this is a look a mother can be proud of.”

Despite winning five-star reviews around the world, Hans was more humble when asked about his accolades.

He said the response from audience members was far more important to him.

“The biggest joy I get from my show is to see the audience dancing and having a good time,” Hans said.

“Maybe it's because they are a bit drunk but it's still good to see them enjoying themselves.”

“I hope they have a lot of fun and learn not to take things too seriously.”

Hans added he hoped to catch some local acts while in town for Fringe World.

“I mean, look at what you've given us over the years — from Joel Creasey to Megan Gale and Rose Hancock, you've really served us some of the best,” he said.

Mein Camp is on at the De Parel Spiegel tent from Saturday to Thursday.

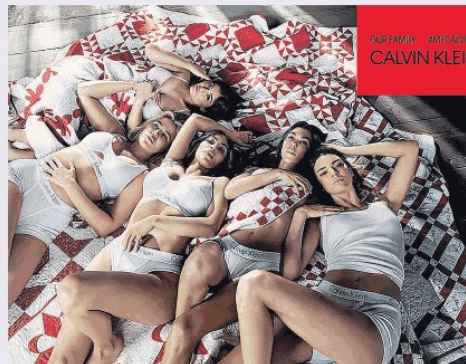
